This trophy to be awarded annually to the horse/pony rider combination gaining the most points in Dressage competitions with scores over 55%, jumping competition with BEF designators judged under Table A and Combined Training and/or Horse Trials. It also honours his constant companion and friend, Annie, a Nubian goat who always came to shows with him, to the delight of spectators. Orvy was a true champion, always giving his best performance in every competition. It is therefore fitting that the Show Jumper of the Year be awarded this honour in his memory.
