and in any direction during a fixed time. Each obstacle carries from IO to I20 points according to its difficulty. Combinations are not allowed. At the end of the time allowed, the competitor must cross the finish line in order for their time to be recorded. Each obstacle may be jumped twice. The competitor with the highest number of points will be declared the winner (fastest time will decide in the event of equality of points). An obstacle may be provided as part of the course, duly marked by flags and called "Joker". The Joker may be jumped twice:

200 points are awarded each time this obstacle is jumped correctly, but if it is knocked down, 200 points must be deducted from the total points
